Examinations to manage risks and to prevent cardiovascular events

1. Blood and urine tests (BNP, cardiac troponin, D-dimer, etc.)

Heart failure, thrombosis, and risk factor evaluation

2. Holter ECG monitoring

Bradycardia, tachycardia, and arrhythmia evaluation

3. Echocardiogram

Cardiac function, valvular disease, congenital heart disease, cardiac hypertrophy

4. Carotid ultrasound, pulse wave velocity

Arteriosclerosis evaluation



5. Coronary CT, lower extremity CT angiography, brain MRI

Arteries, coronary artery, and cerebral aneurysm evaluation

6. Options (if applicable)

- 1) Lower limb venous ultrasound (if high D-dimer)
- 2) Sleep apnea test (if the patient is obese)
- 3) 24-hour ambulatory blood pressure monitoring (if the patient has hypertension)
- 4) Stress myocardial scintigraphy (if cannot use contrast agents)
